What is UrbanPlan?

UrbanPlan is a **FREE** education programme for sixth form students, led by facilitators and industry experts. It explores the market and non-market tensions involved in urban regeneration.

Who is the workshop for?

- Sixth form students (and high ability year 11)
- Curriculum fit for Geography and Business Studies A-levels
- Students keen to learn more about careers in the built environment
- 30 students per workshop

How long does the workshop last?

There is a fully resourced, short preparatory lesson delivered by the teacher in class one week before the visit.

The workshop lasts a full day (eg 9am - 3.30pm) which we can adapt to suit your day.

What will students do?

UrbanPlan is an immersive, energetic and thought-provoking workshop for sixth form students, introducing them to the exciting world of urban regeneration.

Students form property development companies to regenerate a city centre site. Simulating real-life, students work through financial, design, ethical and environmental challenges in order to create a financially viable scheme comprising a mix of commercial and residential uses. Once designed, their final challenge is to present their ideas to a specialist panel (built environment professionals) and receive expert feedback.

This is an interactive, exciting and competitive session, in which each student is allocated a role and is challenged to contribute. They will develop their employability skills and receive individual mentoring from built environment industry experts.

Easy-to-use multimedia resources include a teachers' toolkit, templates and 3D models for pupils to work with as well as briefing films and software packages.
